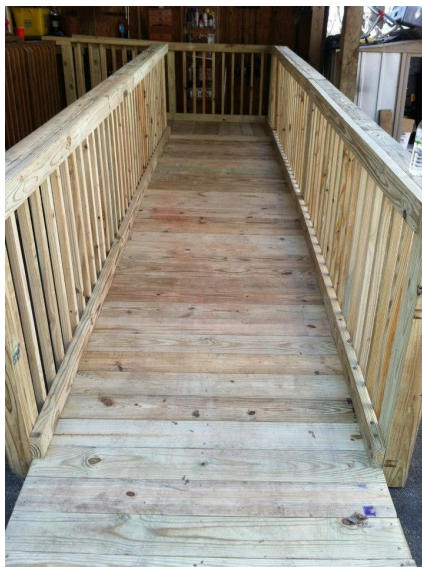

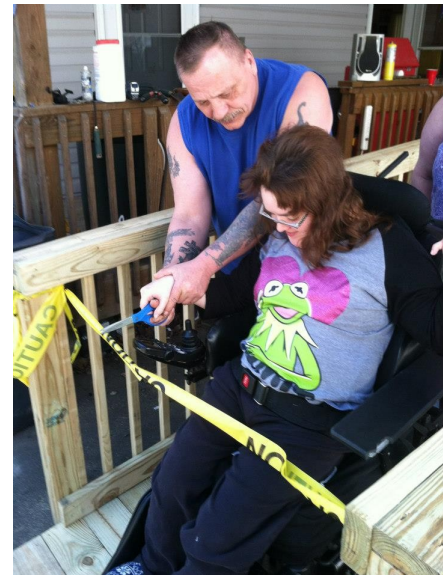


Picking up where we left off ...

Irma McGowan lived in the trailer on Stein Road in Greene in 40 years. The 50 year old trailer was not in any condition to be repaired, so The Impact Project demolished it. We brought in a used trailer and refurbished it. By the time we were finished, the trailer was like new! Irma moved into her new home on May 29.

***We’ll Take Your Junk Day!**

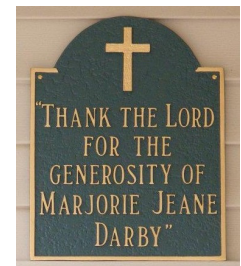
As a fundraiser for The Impact Project we will take your junk!
