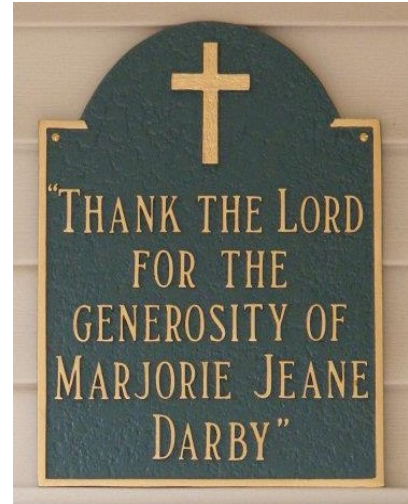


Saving Souls One House at a Time
